## Training obligation for station staff

Dear Sir or Madam,

We would like to expressly point out the obligation to train station staff.

If the staff of an air carrier is employed in Germany for a longer period of time (indication is the presence of an airport ID card) and this staff performs aviation security-related activities in accordance with the points

- 11.2.3.6 (aircraft security search),
- 11.2.3.7 (protection of aircraft) or
- 11.2.3.8 (baggage reconciliation)

of the Annex to the Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/1998, this personnel must be trained accordingly.

We kindly ask for your knowledge and attention.

The Luftfahrt-Bundesamt will monitor compliance with these requirements as part of its supervisory activities.
